Letter from the PRESIDENT



Since our last Annual Report, we have experienced an incredibly bizarre year. Many times throughout 2020, I have prayed about the verse from Deuteronomy. I so vividly recall being with our students at our last pep rally on March 13. It was the Friday before Spring Break. The students were all dressed in purple and gold, united in their cheers and chants, dancing together in the gym. I especially enjoyed seeing the sequined

dance team uniforms from the 80s that our seniors wore specifically for that day.

Before our closing prayer, I spoke with the students and reminded them to make good decisions while on Spring Break. I explained to them that there was a chance we might not be able to return in a week but that they shouldn't worry because whatever the future holds, we'd get through it together. We then closed out our pep rally with a prayer and general excitement for a much-needed break. Only hours later, before I had even left for the day, I learned of various schools, sports seasons, and businesses that were planning to close, not for a week but until June 1st.

The COVID-19 pandemic hit each of us in the Rosati-Kain community differently. Though all of us were confined to our homes, some lost jobs while others lost loved ones.

As our students were trying to make sense of their day-to-day reality, the teachers were simply outstanding. With little to no preparation on how to be a distance teacher and how to help students navigate challenges unrelated to academics, the teachers not only effectively continued course instruction but, more significantly, found themselves regularly checking in and ministering to their

students well-beyond the scope of academic content. As a community, we were able to support the emotional, social, and spiritual needs of our students.

In the midst of the pandemic, it's important to note that our nation witnessed the tragic death of George Floyd after he was arrested on May 20, 2020 in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Social unrest soon swept our city and nation, sparking an important conversation about racial inequity. Numerous Rosati-Kain alumnae, parents, and faculty reached out to us with a call to action as well as offering assistance in creating a more inclusive community at Rosati-Kain. At Rosati-Kain we denounce racism and remain committed to diversity, inclusion, and creating an environment where our young women are encouraged to be themselves. We recognize there is much work to be done and reaffirm our pledge to stand with our community and continue conversations in the unified goal of promoting cultural competency at Rosati-Kain.

In an effort to press forward through these challenging times, we started our fall Semester earlier than usual on August 5th. Not having been in the classroom since Mid-March, the faculty and students alike wanted to be back together. We were fortunate that Saint Louis the King grade school, which had closed a few years ago, was made available to us. Numerous long hours by several individuals readied this building for our freshmen and sophomores. As a result, we have all grades coming to school every day. Some students are in situations where it is best for them to be a distance-learner, so they continue to attend classes virtually.

During times such as these, we naturally become fearful and we question, "Where is God amidst all this suffering?" The verse above reminds us that these times of uncertainty are our opportunities to grow in holiness. The Lord goes before us and makes straight our path. The Lord will never forsake us. We can trust that God is holding us in the palm of His hand, and we do not need to be afraid.

Know of our gratitude to you, our friends. We simply could not be here for these young women each day if it were not for your support. Rosati-Kain is such a beautiful and holy place, where each girl can be herself as she grows to be who God created her to be.

Letter from the PRINCIPAL



Rosati-Kain High School has educated students for over one hundred years. And throughout its long history as a faith-

based school for young women, there have been many challenges. This recent pandemic was not our first. Rosati-Kain first dealt with widespread shutdowns in 1918, during the influenza pandemic and again in 1942, during World War II. During these challenging times, the faculty and students persevered. It is what we continue to do today. Our faculty and staff effectively adapted to a virtual learning schedule for the last academic quarter of the 2019-2020 school year. Gratefully, under the direction of Mr. Paul Antonacci, Rosati-Kain was also in the third year of iPad integration and our students adjusted to this new style of learning.

The final months of the school year were particularly different for our senior class. With social distancing rules in place, events such as Prom, Senior Lock-In and Class Night were unable to take place. And yet our seniors remained positive about their futures. We celebrated the class with our first ever Graduation Parade. Seniors decorated their cars and paraded down Lindell Blvd and throughout the CWE to much applause from their teachers, family and local CWE neighbors. It was a celebration we will all remember for years to come. A limited Graduation Ceremony took place in June, for a final send off to the Class of 2020. We all wish them well in their future endeavors.

The summer continued to be a busy time for our faculty and staff, preparing for the upcoming school year. Rosati-Kain would need to adapt. And with the help of our friends at the Cathedral Basilica, we were given the space to do so. We are grateful to Msgr. Henry Breier for lending us the extra space to bring our students back to school safely. With the help of our beloved D.O.R.K.S. (Dads Of Rosati-Kain Students), ten classrooms were set up with desks, walls were painted, gyms and cafes were cleaned and R-K West was created for the freshmen and sophomores. We offer thanks to our Kougar Kommunity for their efforts to keep our students in school during these challenging times.

Near the end of the summer, we received another gift to the school, in the form of a therapy animal. This has been a longtime goal for our Director of School Counseling, Jamie Burke, and it could not have come at a more opportune time. Our newest Kougar is an 18-month-old Labradoodle named Edge. Jamie and Edge make up a Certified Assistance Team and both have undergone extensive training to prepare as Edge becomes a part of the Rosati-Kain community. In the first months of the new school year, Edge and the students have adapted well to each other, and we look forward to having her here for many years to come.

The 2019-2020 school year was certainly full of surprises for us all. We are thankful for the community of people that have helped Rosati-Kain succeed and those who support us during these unprecedented times.

Promoting Racial Equity at Rosati-Kain

As a Catholic community of faith, committed to diversity and inclusion, Rosati-Kain High School reaffirms our conviction that racism has no place in this world. We stand together with our community and support the need for a call to action. We are committed to doing the work that is necessary and continue to engage in conversations with our students and our R-K community so that we can work towards a more equitable society.

We know it is only through continuous and intentional re-examining of structures and programs that we can enlighten the minds and form the hearts of our students. At this time, Rosati-Kain has retained two professional consultants, Anjanette Morrow Clark '83 and Michelle Martin Bonner '84, as well as three expert alumnae, Jeane Mitchell-Carr '84, Tracey Handal '88, and Dionne Peeples Jones '86, to facilitate this endeavor. These consultants and three alumnae came together to form an advisory committee. So far this team has facilitated numerous listening sessions that have led to the creation of committees as a start to advance these goals.

At the forefront of these committees is the Curriculum Review Committee. This committee, led by Anjanette and comprised of several faculty members, will strengthen the current Rosati-Kain curriculum to be inclusive and equitable of various cultures and races. Through the use of significant research, a curriculum map for cultural competence has been developed and is being integrated into each course's learning objectives. The remaining committees are addressing how to best serve Rosati-Kain students, parents, and alumnae with the ultimate goal of becoming the social justice hub for the greater St. Louis community.

We recognize this is merely a launching point and we are working to provide more resources for our students and staff. A Safer R-K

When the students left the halls of R-K in March 2020 for Spring Break, Rosati-Kain did not know how the final months of the school year would unfold. The Novel Coronavirus Disease, COVID-19, was declared a pandemic by the World Health Organization by mid-March, and the United States issued a state of emergency for the country a few days later. True to form, Rosati-Kain sprung into action. Our faculty and staff met via many Zoom meetings and phone calls to discuss the final months of schooling and how that would look for our students. The safety and well-being of R-K students and staff will always be our top priority. We are committed to protecting our girls in the face of these worldly challenges without diminishing the quality of their education.

The final months of the 2019-2020 school year were conducted virtually. Our teachers pivoted quickly to accommodate online learning. R-K hosted a smaller, socially distant Graduation Ceremony for the seniors and Junior Ring mass for the junior class. All events for the year were essentially cancelled or postponed. The summer of 2020 provided little rest for our faculty. Teachers worked tirelessly to prepare for the restart of school in the fall and the many unknowns that came with it.

R-K worked with several vendors to make sure the school would be ready for students to return safely. The Cathedral Basilica graciously lent us their grade school building, giving us the room we needed to adhere to social distancing guidelines so that students could return safely to in-person classes. We want to acknowledge one vendor in particular, our contracted cleaning company, Peace of Mind Cleaning Services, Inc. Founded by R-K alumna Dionne Peeples Jones '86 and her husband Simon, Peace of Mind Cleaning Services has proudly maintained the halls of R-K since the summer of 2016.

"Our team has always understood that the main job of a custodian is to care. We've cared about the young women at R-K long before Covid-19," Dionne said. "Our team has been disinfecting desks, chairs, doorknobs, light switches, handrails and everything else at R-K every day since we started four years ago. The only addition to the cleaning process is the use of an electrostatic sprayer, which is an added layer of disinfecting. Doing our part to make sure the girls are safe and in a clean, healthy environment has always been important to us."

Dionne's team works diligently each night to clean windowsills, door handles, desks, floors and everything in-between. New deep-cleaning products are used to disinfect the school each night, to ensure the safety of the students during these unprecedented times. Dionne has been a proud alumna of Rosati-Kain since 1986, and we are grateful to have her and her team at Peace of Mind Cleaning Services, Inc. taking care of our school and everyone who comes through our doors.

COMPUTER SCIENCE



The curriculum at Rosati-Kain High School strives to empower and challenge the young women of R-K. Every year, classes are evaluated and new ideas are brought to the table. This year, R-K is working with local non-profit, LaunchCode. The mission of LaunchCode is to educate and train future leaders in technology. Rosati-Kain is one of the first high schools to bring the new LCHS program into its curriculum. There are ten juniors taking this course, and it is taught by faculty member Abby Faron McGillicuddy, '13.

"Computer Science wasn't offered at Rosati-Kain when I was a student. Now I am back as a teacher, trying to find the best way to offer it to my students. Being a part of the LaunchCode High School community connects me with fellow teachers who are working together to create new opportunities in Computer Science for students."

The technology industry is thriving, and Rosati-Kain supports women in tech, now more than ever. R-K alumna, Mandy Shultz, '09 works for LaunchCode, and she was a speaker at R-K's Career Day last year. Mandy continues to shine with her work as a Donor Relations Associate for LaunchCode. R-K staff worked with Mandy to bring student volunteers to the 2019 GeekGala at the LaunchCode headquarters. Four students volunteered their time for the successful event last fall.

"I'm so excited that Rosati-Kain is participating in LCHS with LaunchCode!" said Mandy. "This is a transformative

Creativity

IN TIMES OF CHANGE

The Art Room has always been a beloved spot at Rosati-Kain High School. From 1927 to 2020, students have always been able to take art classes. The current art room looked very different in 1927, as it was located in a regular classroom. In 1953, art classes were moved to the current room on the third floor, known previously as the sewing room. Today, R-K offers 10 different art classes for sophomores, juniors and seniors, from painting to pottery and jewelry making.

In 2019, The art room received a grant for a much-needed renovation. The D.O.R.K.S. helped move out all supplies, desks and artwork to renovate the room. New pottery equipment, flooring, shelves and more were added to create an open space for students to practice their art.

In the Spring of 2020, our Art Teacher, Jill Hetherington '11, had to pivot, along with all of our faculty and staff, to virtual learning. Art supplies were difficult to come by, and shipments were delayed. Miss Hetherington kept her

students motivated, sharing videos of ways to practice their art using items around their own home. When she was unable to order more canvases, she used an old picture frame, painting a beautiful nature scene on the glass.

When classes resumed for the current semester, Jill again adjusted to teaching students in the regular art room, as well as the new art room in R-K West (the Cathedral grade school building). Students were encouraged to decorate the new school building with their art, painting

symbols of R-K along the walls, and classes continue to move outdoors during beautiful weather. While our current students still love their original art room, they continue to experience creativity and ingenuity outside of the classroom with Ms. Hetherington's innovative teaching style. Even with these adjustments, R-K was able to offer classes to over 130 students last year. The curriculum has not changed, despite new challenges for this school year, and just as many students began their new art classes in August.

Sr. Vinny graduated from R-K with the Class of 1960, and has remained an active member of the Kougar Kommunity ever since. She earned a Bachelor's Degree in history at the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis and a Master's Degree in history from Lincoln University in Jefferson City. She was a primary, intermediate and secondary teacher in Missouri, Illinois and California for over 30 years. She

also served as a high school campus minister in California. She was the director of the Newman Center and a history and religion teacher at Lincoln University in Jefferson City, MO.






