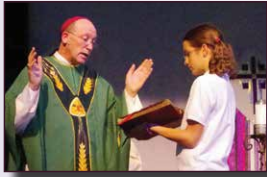

# WHO'S DOING WHAT?

## STUDENTS

### NATIONAL MERIT SEMIFINALIST

**Madeline Lane, '15** was named a National Merit Semifinalist. She will have an opportunity to continue in the competition, competing



with other students across the nation, for awards worth about \$2.5 million that will be offered next spring. Each Semifinalist submits a detailed scholarship application, which includes essays and information about

extracurricular achievements, awards, and leadership positions. Semifinalists also have to have an outstanding academic record, be endorsed and recommended by a school official, and earn SAT scores that confirm their qualifying test performance. Scholarship winners represent less than 1% of the initial pool of student entrants, based on official statistics released by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. Way to represent R-K!

achievement, to encourage local schools to improve and expand gifted education programs, and to assist in providing the state with experienced faculty and specialized curriculum for such students.

Every public and private high school in the state is allowed to nominate at least one student for the Academy. Academically, students represent the top one-half of one percent of the state's sophomore class.

### KRUPINSKI ACADEMY OF DANCE



**Emily Hofer, '18** attended summer dance camp at Krupinski Academy of Dance, where she's been dancing since second grade. She danced 6 weeks, 4 days a week, 6 hours a day. Emily also recently auditioned and made the Teen Dance Ensemble at Krupinski for this school year.

## Remembering Pamela Beggs Johnston

Pamela Beggs Johnston, '63, who passed away after a brief illness in June, 2014, is remembered by her husband Chuck as a "tremendous and remarkable" woman who valued what Rosati-Kain gave her as a student, and who wanted to provide opportunities for other young women to carry on the tradition of the four charisms: caritas, humilitas, scientia and virtus to others. As part of their estate plan, Pam and Chuck Johnston have bequeathed a generous gift for the establishment of the Pamela B. Johnston, '63 Scholarship, which will provide tuition assistance as needed, and also augment the academic programs which challenge Rosati-Kain students as

they prepare to find their place in the world.

After graduating from R-K in 1963, Pam attended St. Louis University, and later worked at the Ambassador's Desk for Trans World Airlines, where she coordinated travel arrangements for business executives. Pam and Chuck met at a TWA event, had their first date on St. Patrick's Day, and married in 1973. Seasoned travelers, during their lifetime together they visited England, France, Spain, Portugal, Germany and Egypt, among other destinations. Their life together, however, focused on how they could incorporate serving others in ways both large and small.

Generosity and service to others were very much a part of Pam's life; she was known as the "St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry Angel," and worked extensively

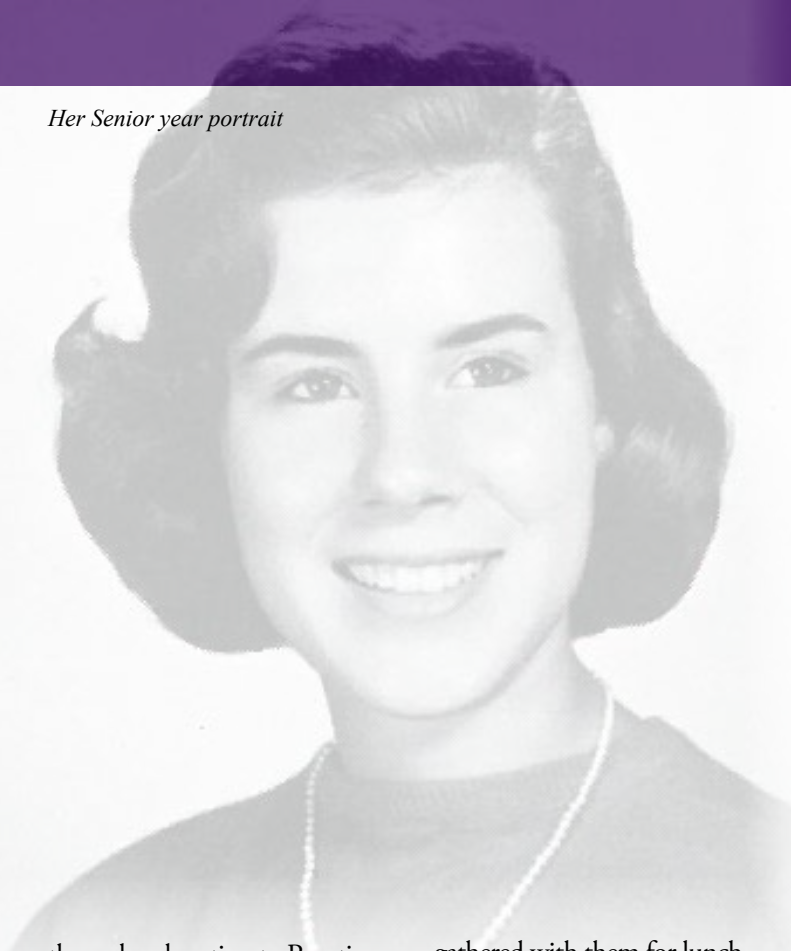
with the St. Catherine of Labour Food Pantry as well. She was described as "a tireless worker" within her parish, Seven Holy Founders, where

she provided volunteer service to the school and the Cub Scouts. Pam was also active in both the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Children of the American Revolution organizations. When describing Pam's charitable work and contributions, Chuck said that, "she loved to help and get things

done. But so much of her work was done anonymously—she touched many lives, but most people never knew."

Honoring Pam's memory





through a donation to Rosati-Kain was the obvious choice for Chuck. "I had an opportunity to see thru Pamela's eyes. I saw a school that turns young ladies into well-educated women and prepares them to continue their education and growth, and to be curious, questioning what is not understood.

"When I look at Rosati-Kain's R-K Today, Spring 2014 publication, I see the women who are continuing their education and the schools they are attending. I can see how the past four years have prepared them for whatever is next.

"Pam was a ROSATI GIRL. She was sharp and bright. She was always a generous, creative person who got things done. I know she would want us to provide this opportunity to others."

An active alumna, Pam kept in touch with her classmates from the Class of 1963, and frequently

gathered with them for lunch and catching-up. Many of her classmates attended a memorial liturgy in her honor in August. A memorial card of her classmates' signatures holds a place of honor in their home, and Chuck said that he was always very moved by the "cohesiveness and closeness" that Pam and Rosati-Kain grads maintained after graduation.

As Pam devoted much of her life to helping others, the generous gift in her honor was accomplished through her husband and his financial advisors with his estate plan. The Pamela B. Johnston, '63 Scholarship, will provide an ongoing tribute to a true "ROSATI GIRL." 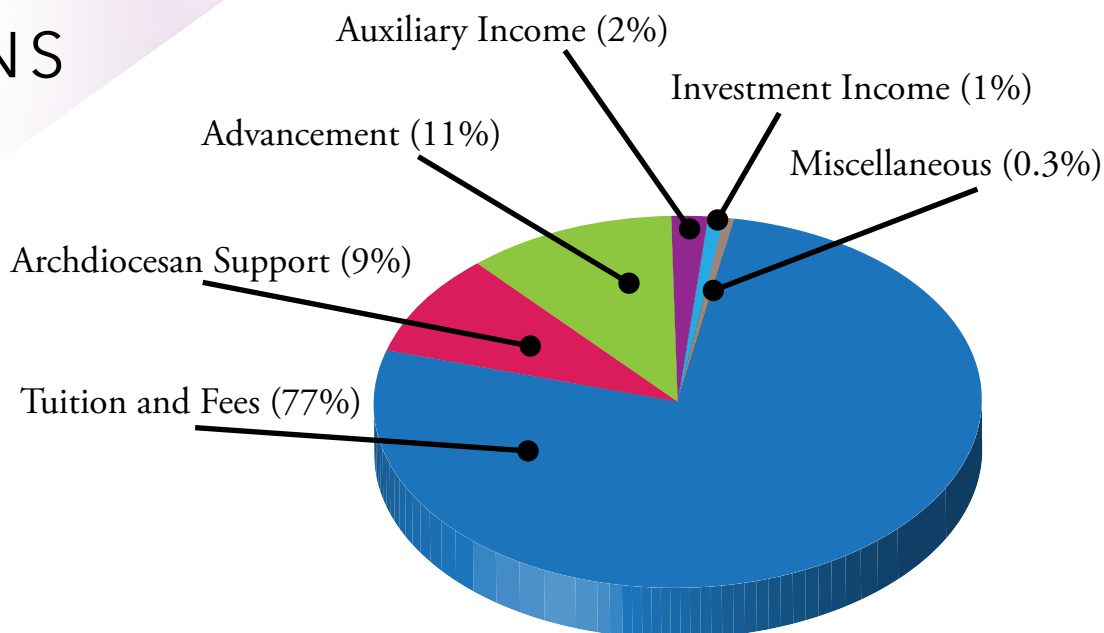

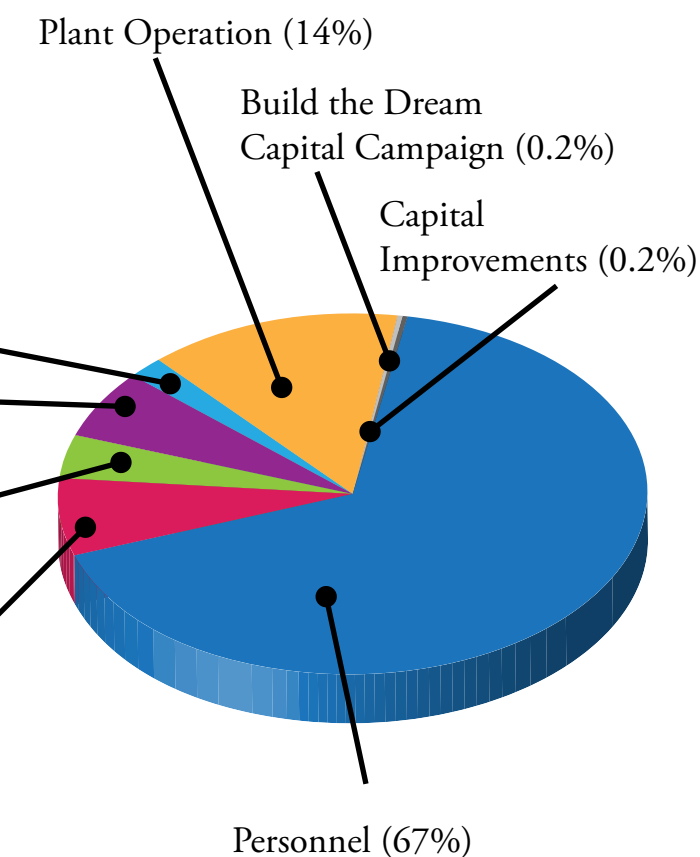

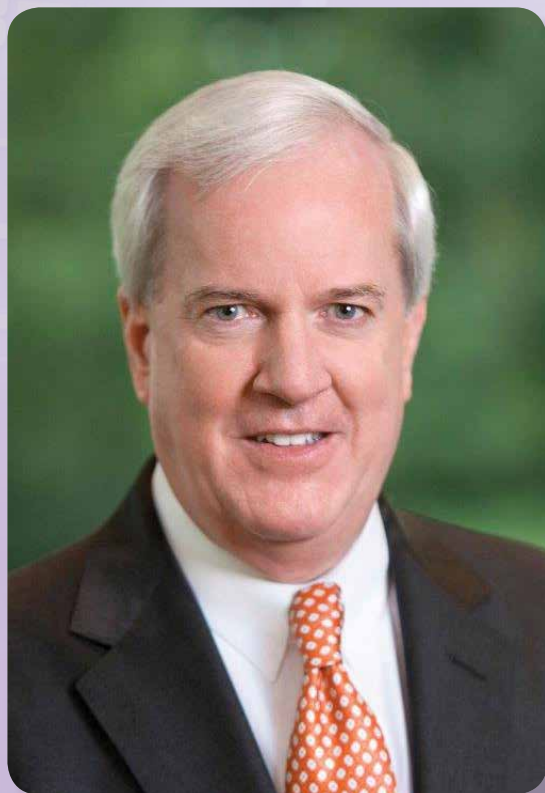
